We are excited to be starting something new this year. Moving forward, we will no longer be consigning bulls anywhere else and will be hosting our own sale.

This year's offering is very small due to several factors, but a big reason is that we had nearly a 70% heifer crop last year—especially during the calving of our A.I. and embryo calves.

Our calves are not creep fed, and we do not push our bulls. We develop them to hold up and last, feeding a high-roughage ration designed for gains of just over 3 pounds per day. You also won't find overfed, fat, fluffy show bulls here.

You won't find many terminal bulls in this offering. Our focus is on maternal genetics—easy-fleshing cows that don't require as much feed while still raising big calves. We are proud to be recognized as a MaternalPlus® herd by the American Angus Association.

We are also proud to have had 9 cows earn Pathfinder status with the American Angus Association this year, and over 25% of the cows in our herd have achieved Pathfinder status at some point. This year's offering includes bull calves out of Pathfinder dams, including 059, with a natural weaning ratio of 9 @ 113.

Please come out and take a look at the bulls. If you'd like, I'm sure the boys will be happy to give you a tour and show off any cows, calves, or replacement heifers you'd like to see that day.

We are working hard to build pens for sale day and figure out how to host a sale on our own. We're very excited about starting something new, and we want to do it right as we move forward.

We hope you'll attend—whether it's your first time or you're a repeat customer. Please join us for a meal starting at 11:00 a.m., and we will begin selling bulls at 1:00 p.m.

- If a replacement bull is available, one will be provided.
- If a replacement bull is not available, a credit will be issued for use at our next sale.

With over 17,000 progeny having been registered, he doesn't need much introduction. Resource is known for his ability to change a cow in one generation. He is well known for his body capacity, fleshing ability, structure and temperament. These Resource sons are full brothers out of a flush of my 059 cow. There is a video of 059 on our web page at 12 years of age, perfect feet and udder, we had to let her go this winter just shy of her 16th birthday. She had a natural weaning ratio of 9@113. If you look at her EPD's or her sons you will be disappointed, she did not win the genomic lottery for sure, but don't miss the phenotype. She has 3 pathfinder daughters in the herd, and daughters with ratios of 10@103, 9@109, 3@111 and 3@107. We retained a full brother to these flush brothers that is 5 this year, he is a phenotypical standout. These are the last 3 calves of the flush, there are no more 059 embryos.

The Resource × 059 cross (059 was top 10% \$EN and top 3% Milk) is going to leave you with some of the best females you can make. Don't get hung up on the rest of the EPDs on these three flush brothers look at the phenotype. We sold 059 this winter at 16 years old: a Pathfinder cow with three Pathfinder daughters still in the herd. Don't overlook these three.

It's hard to find much wrong with Architect. Progeny are high-octane growth cattle with depth and rib shape and an easy-fleshing look. The now deceased sire will have limited semen availability, but if you're looking for some, I'm your guy. We will have several wet first calf daughters of Architect right next to the red shed where we are serving lunch in on sale day, we invite you to check them out, and they will mostly have Bear Mtn North Star calves on their side. Beside the depth and rib shape one of the main reasons I first used Architect was his yearling frame of 5.6. There are enough giraffes in the Angus world and nothing wrong with a smaller framed high octane Angus cow.
